

# Nebraska College of Technical Agriculture

**Note:** The Nebraska College of Technical Agriculture (NCTA), under the control and management of the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, has a statewide mission of instruction relating to food and agriculture at the less than baccalaureate level, with concentration on the applied associate degree (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 85-121). Consequently, the entire state is considered to be the NCTA's service area.

Following are two maps showing the statewide enrollment of Nebraska-resident first-time freshmen at the NCTA in fall 2006 by county.

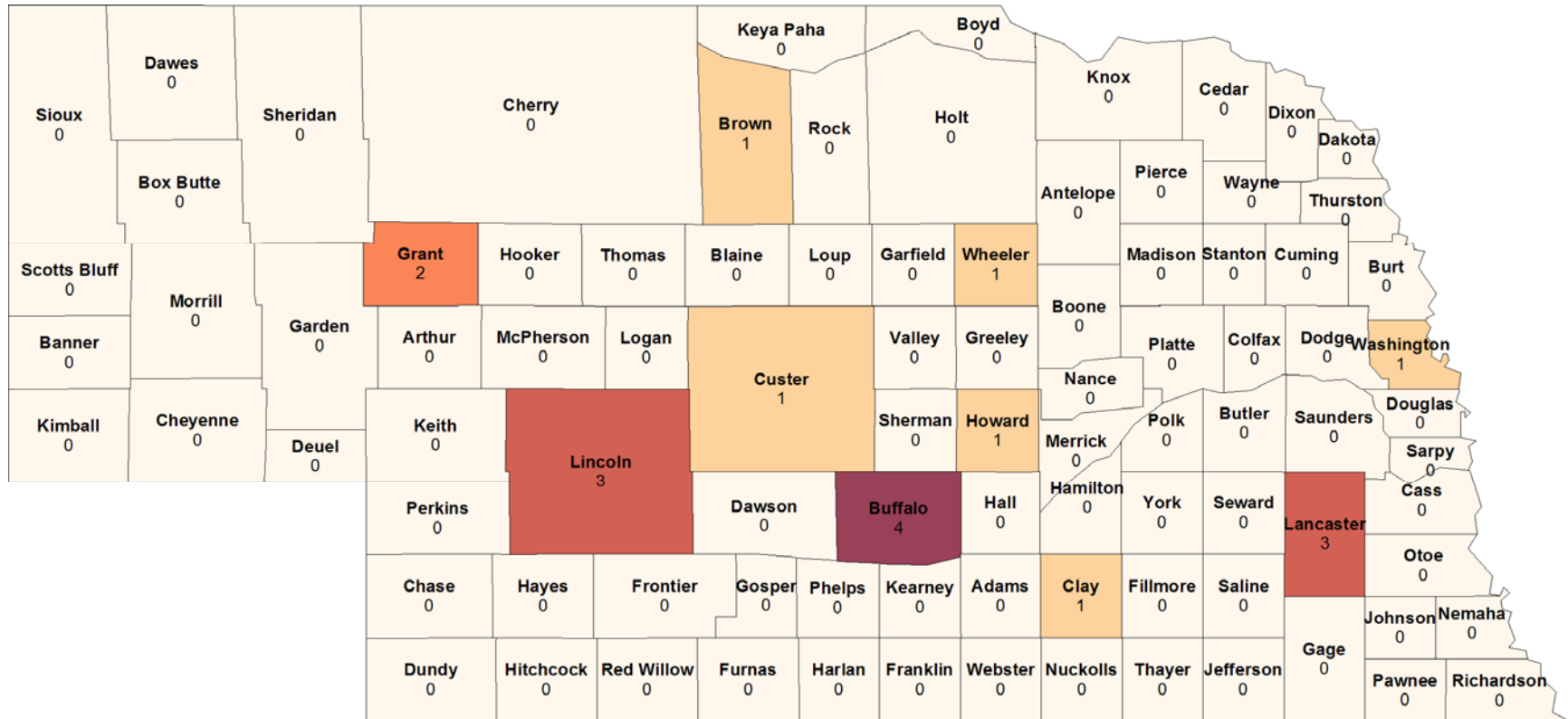
The first map shows the number of first-time freshmen from Nebraska who enrolled at the NCTA within 12 months of high school graduation. As shown on this map, known counties of residence were reported for 89 of the 91 freshmen in this category, indicating that the NCTA attracts recent high school graduates from across the state.

The second map shows that county of residence was reported for only 18 of the 74 Nebraskans who enrolled at the NCTA in fall 2006 as first-time freshmen more than 12 months after they graduated from high school. No county of residence was reported for the remaining 56 freshmen in this category.
