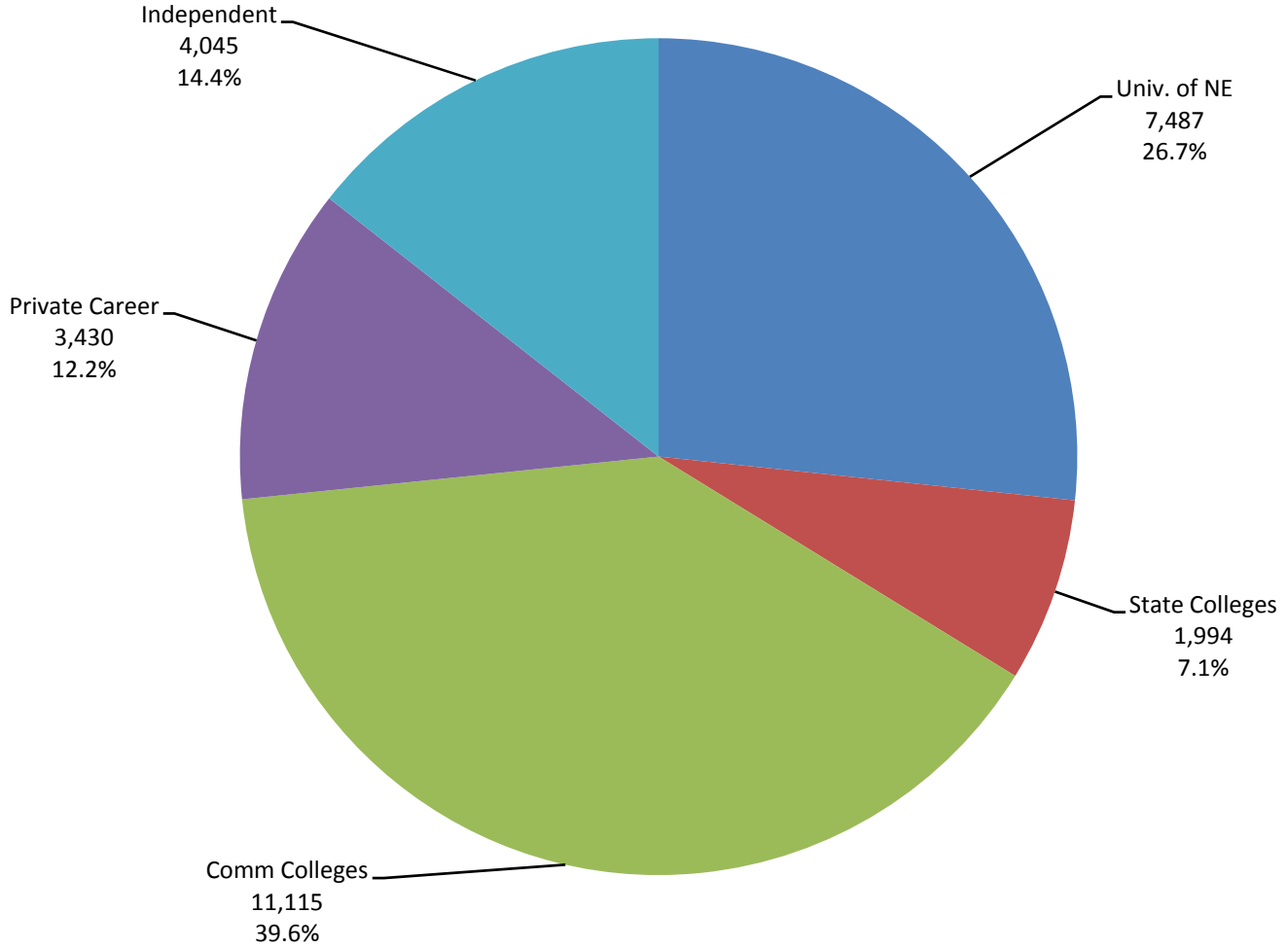

# Application Process

- Students (and parents for dependent students) complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
  - FAFSA determines eligibility for Pell Grant
- All Nebraska resident Pell Grant eligible students can be considered for a state grant
- For 2007-08, 28,071 NE residents qualified for the Pell Grant

2007-08**



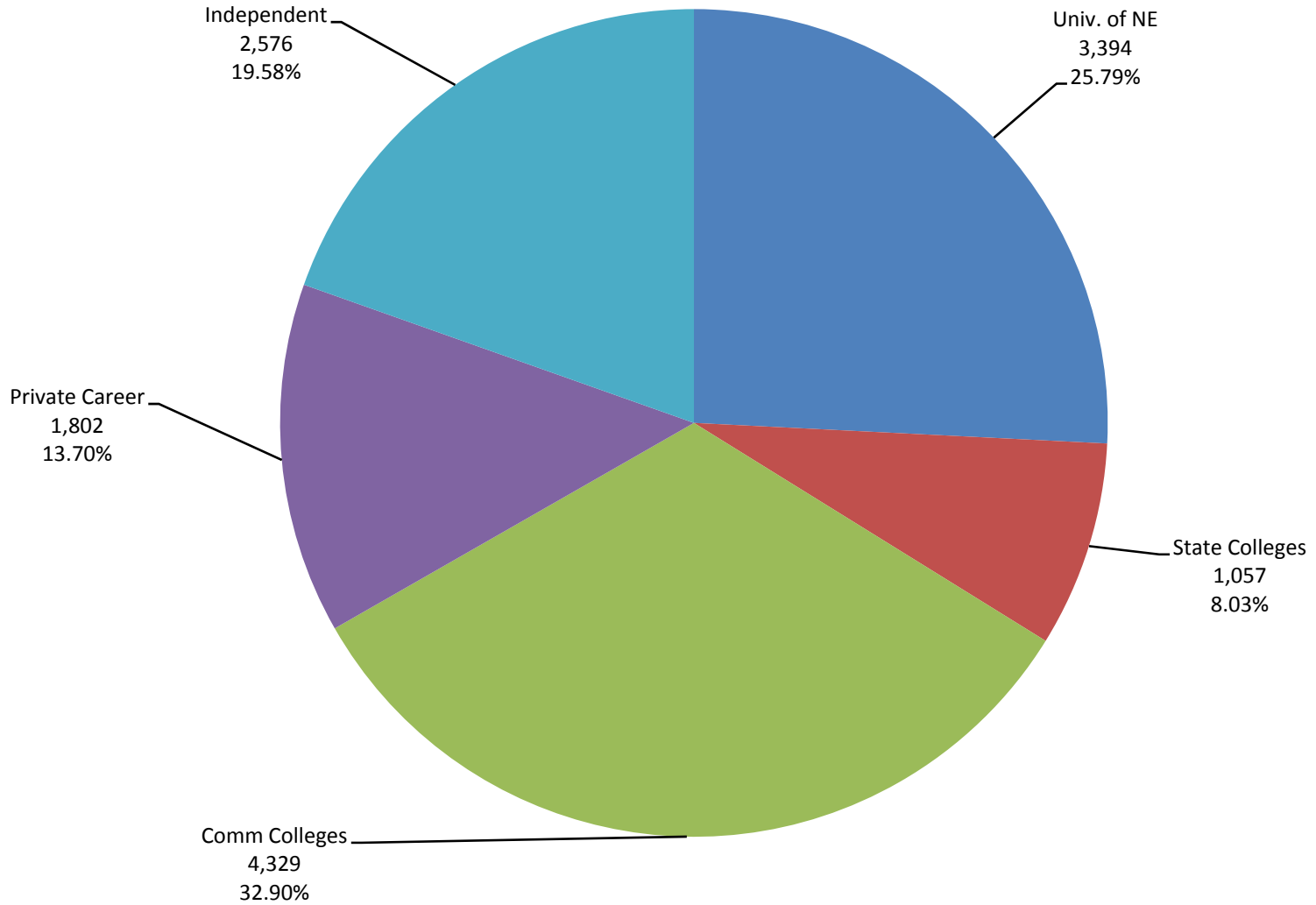
# Awarding Process

- CCPE determines allocation for each institution based on formula in statute
- Institutions recommend students and amounts to be awarded
- CCPE approves or denies based on yearly maximums – institution and student

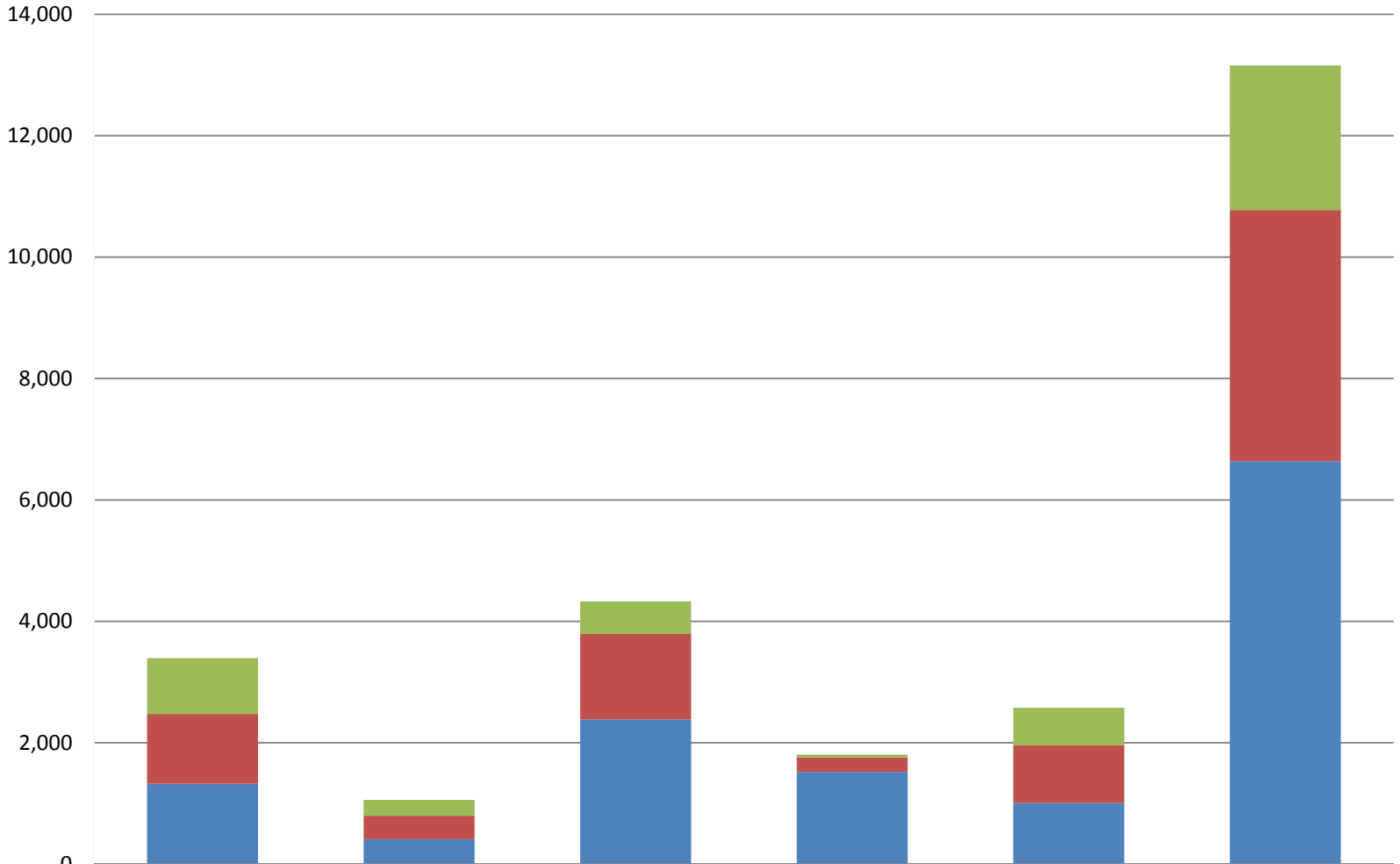
# 2007-08 NSG Info

- 13,158 students received a NSG
- 46.9% of eligible students
- Average Grant - \$944.05

### Total Recipients by Sector 2007-08

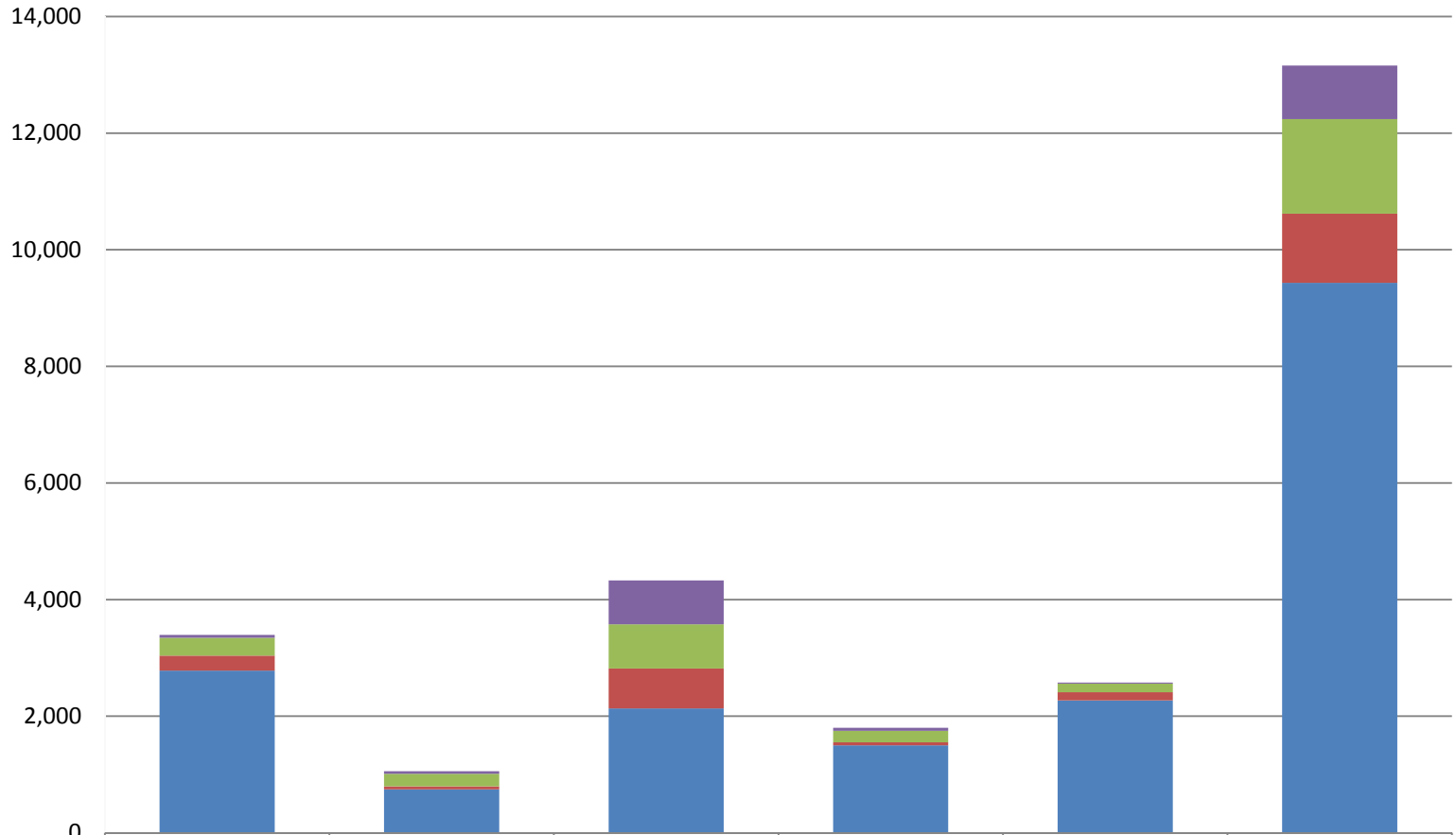


### Total 2007-08 Recipients by Sector by Income
