

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
NEBRASKA COORDINATING COMMISSION  
FOR POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION**

The Nebraska Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education will hold a public hearing on June 18, 2009, at 1:30 p.m. CDT in Room 1524 at the State Capitol in Lincoln, Nebraska. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public testimony regarding the study of Nebraska's community college system as mandated by Neb. Laws 2009, LB 340.

LB 340 directs the Commission to investigate the role and mission of the colleges, the weighting of courses for reimbursement purposes, the role of the Nebraska Community College Association or a similar entity, membership in such an entity, and coordination in the absence of such an entity.
