# Nebraska P-16 Initiative

## Proposed Increase in Nebraska's College-Going Rate to Reach the Top 10 Nationally

This report outlines a proposed strategy to achieve the Nebraska P-16 Initiative's goal to **improve Nebraska's college-going rate to the Top 10 tier nationally.**

Based on the latest available state comparisons, Nebraska ranked 19<sup>th</sup> among the 50 states in fall 2006, with a college-going rate that was 3.7% below the state ranked in 10<sup>th</sup> place. Since many other states, if not all states, are trying to raise their college-going rates, Nebraska probably will have to increase its college continuation rate by more than four or five percent to become a top-10 state. Consequently, this proposal is based on the assumption that a six-percent increase is a logical, reasonable goal to reach the top-10 tier in college-going rates.

For the purposes of developing a proposed strategy to improve Nebraska's college-going rate, the best estimate of the state's current college continuation rate is 69%. This is the statewide college going rate for the students who graduated from Nebraska's public high schools during the 2007–2008 school year, based on an analysis of college enrollment records obtained from the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) on April 7, 2009.<sup>2</sup> Adding six percentage points to the estimated current college continuation rate of 69% results in a proposed statewide goal of 75% to reach the top 10 nationally.

In addition to estimating the current statewide college continuation rate of 69%, the Coordinating Commission used the enrollment records from the NSC to estimate the college-going rate of each of the 284 Nebraska public high schools that awarded regular high school diplomas in 2007–2008.<sup>3</sup> For the purpose of these calculations, the estimated college-going rate for each school was defined as the percentage of the school's high school graduates in 2007–2008 who were enrolled in any college or university in the United States on or before April 7, 2009.

<sup>2</sup>Only "on-time" graduates--students who graduated from high school in four years or less--were included in the analysis of Clearinghouse records. The analysis did not include students who graduated from Nebraska's nonpublic (private) high schools or students who required longer than four years to graduate from high school. <sup>3</sup>Public high schools include alternative secondary schools, such as the Millard Learning Center, the Minden Public Schools Success Center and the Fremont Student Service Center. For the purposes of this report, Nebraska public high schools also include the following three schools classified as "state-operated schools" by the Nebraska Department of Education: Geneva North School (which is part of the correctional youth facility for women), the Pine Ridge Job Corps school and the UNL Independent Study High School. One graduate who was incorrectly reported for Hay Springs Elementary School was added to the graduates of Hay Springs High School.

Given the fact that 20,036 students graduated from the state’s public high schools in 2007–2008 and 13,831 of these students were enrolled in college on or before April 7, 2009, the Coordinating Commission determined that 1,196 more students would have had to go to college for the estimated statewide rate to be exactly 75% instead of 69% for the class of 2007–2008. For the development of this proposal, the Commission further analyzed the available data for the state’s 284 public high schools to estimate and propose how many more graduates from each high school will have to go to college in order for the state total to increase by at least 1,196 students and for the corresponding statewide college continuation rate to reach at least 75%. This proposal is based on the assumption, of course, that it is reasonable to use the reported numbers of graduates in 2007–2008 and the numbers of these graduates who went on to college in 2008–2009 as the basis for developing goals for future college continuation rates at the school level.

Proposed Targets for Increasing the College-Going Rates of Nebraska’s Public High Schools

Based on the Coordinating Commission’ analysis, Nebraska’s 284 public high schools can be divided into the five categories listed in Table 1.

The Commission’s analysis of the college continuation data available for the high schools in each group focused on the pool of students who did not go on to college after high school graduation with the objective of determining how many of these students would have to go to college in order to increase the statewide college-going rate to at least 75%. The results of this analysis are summarized in Table 2 on the next page. See the Technical Note beginning on page 5 for a detailed description of the analysis.

Using the procedure described in the Technical Note, the Commission estimates that 1,345, rather than 1,196, more high school graduates continuing to college is a reasonable target if the state wants to safely exceed its goal to reach a statewide college continuation rate of 75%. Specifically, increasing the number of graduates who go on to college by 1,345 will result in an estimated statewide college continuation rate of 75.7%.

Appendix 1 lists Nebraska’s 281 public high schools that awarded regular diplomas in 2007–2008. In this appendix, the schools in each of the five groups are presented in rank order, based on their current college-going rates. This list shows the estimated number of additional students from each school who should be going to college within one year of graduation as its target or goal. Assuming that this goal can and will be reached, the table lists the school’s resulting “new” college going rate. This increased “new” rate is another way of expressing the school’s potential contribution to raising Nebraska’s statewide college continuation rate to 75.7% or to the top 10 nationally. Appendix 2 provides the same information, but lists the schools in alphabetical order by district and school name.

Hypothetical Distribution of Additional Nebraska High School Students Going to College at Nebraska’s Postsecondary Institutions

The Coordinating Commission annually publishes the number of first-time freshmen who have enrolled at the colleges and universities in each of the five major sectors of postsecondary education in Nebraska.<sup>1</sup> Table 3 below shows how the estimated 1,345 additional first-time freshmen would be distributed among these sectors IF they all attended Nebraska institutions and IF they follow exactly the same enrollment pattern as the first-time freshmen in fall 2008.

As shown in Table 3, the University of Nebraska would be expected to attract 39% of the additional Nebraska high school graduates who go to college as a result of the state’s efforts to raise its statewide college-going rate. Initially, it may be more realistic to expect that a lower percentage of the additional students will enroll at the institutions constituting the University of Nebraska, while higher percentages will enroll at the community colleges and for-profit/career schools. However, with improvements in both the quantity and quality of Nebraska’s high school graduates going to college, the percentages who enroll at the University of Nebraska, the state colleges, and the independent institutions are likely to be closer to the current distribution of first-time freshmen.

## **Technical Note**

### **Methodology for Developing Proposed Targets for Increasing the College-Going Rates of Nebraska's Public High Schools**



**Technical Note:**

**Methodology for Developing Proposed Targets for Increasing the College-Going Rates of Nebraska’s Public High Schools**

To develop specific goals for increasing the college-going rates of each of Nebraska’s public high schools, the Coordinating Commission used a methodology that focuses improvement on the pool of students not going to college. This approach places the emphasis for improvement at the school level on reducing the number of students who are not going to college and, as a result, increasing the number who are continuing on to college.

As shown previously, Nebraska’s 284 public high schools can be divided into the five categories listed in Table A.

For each school, the number of graduates who did not go to college was calculated by subtracting the number of students who went to college from the total number of students who graduated in 2007–2008. A targeted percentage decrease in the number of graduates not going to college was then assigned to the schools in each group to determine how many additional students from each high school will have to go to college for the statewide continuation rate to reach at least 75%.<sup>1</sup>

To determine the targeted percentages, the Commission calculated the percentage decrease needed statewide to reduce the number of students not going to college that, in turn, will increase the statewide college-going to at least 75%. This calculated decrease equaled 19.2%, rounded up to 20% for the purpose of proposing targeted goals for each group of high schools.

<sup>1</sup>The additional students from each high school that will have to continue on to college equals the number who did not go to college multiplied by the targeted percentage, rounded to the nearest whole number.

Table B shows the targeted decreases in the number of students not going to college that were assigned to the five groups of high schools.

Since a statewide decrease of 20% is needed, this percentage was assigned to the large schools with already high college-going rates. An additional 10% was added to the goal for large schools with college-going rates currently below the statewide goal of 75%. Alternately, the two groups of small schools were assigned a targeted percentage that is 10% lower than the 20% required statewide. No percentage decrease was assigned to the small schools with very high college-going rates because nearly all of their graduates are already going to college.

Using this approach, Table C on the next page shows that the Coordinating Commission has estimated that 1,345 more Nebraska high school graduates will be going to college if every high school in each group reaches its proposed goal of reducing the number of its graduates who don't go to college within a year of graduation. The Commission further calculated that an increase of 1,345 graduates going to college will result in an increased statewide college continuation rate of 75.7% for the public schools.
