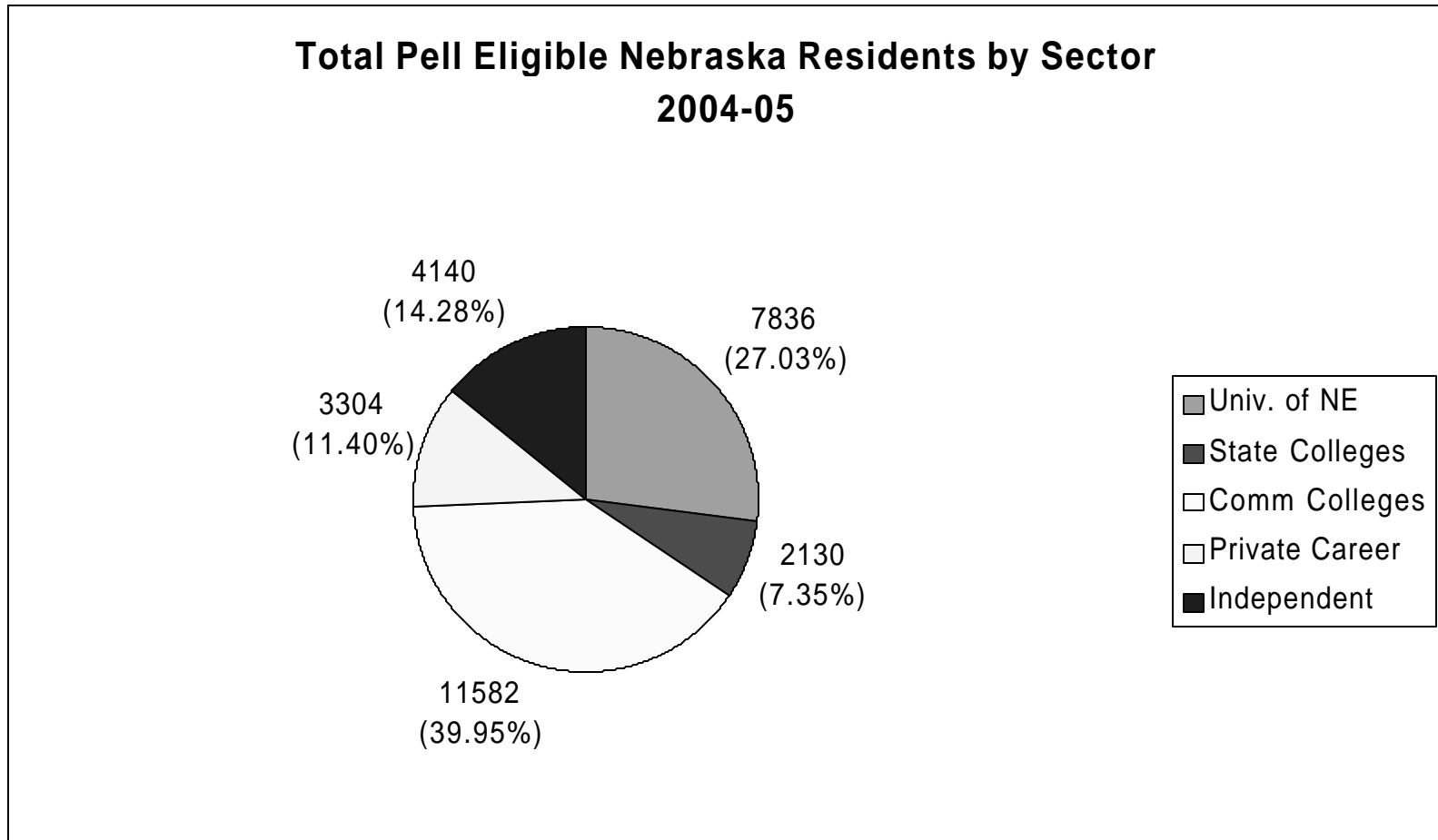

Application Process

- Students (and parents for dependent students) complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - FAFSA determines eligibility for Pell Grant
- All Nebraska resident Pell Grant eligible students can be considered for a state grant
- Fall 2004 headcount enrollment – 123,295
- For 2004-05, 28,992 NE residents qualified for the Pell Grant (24.42%)

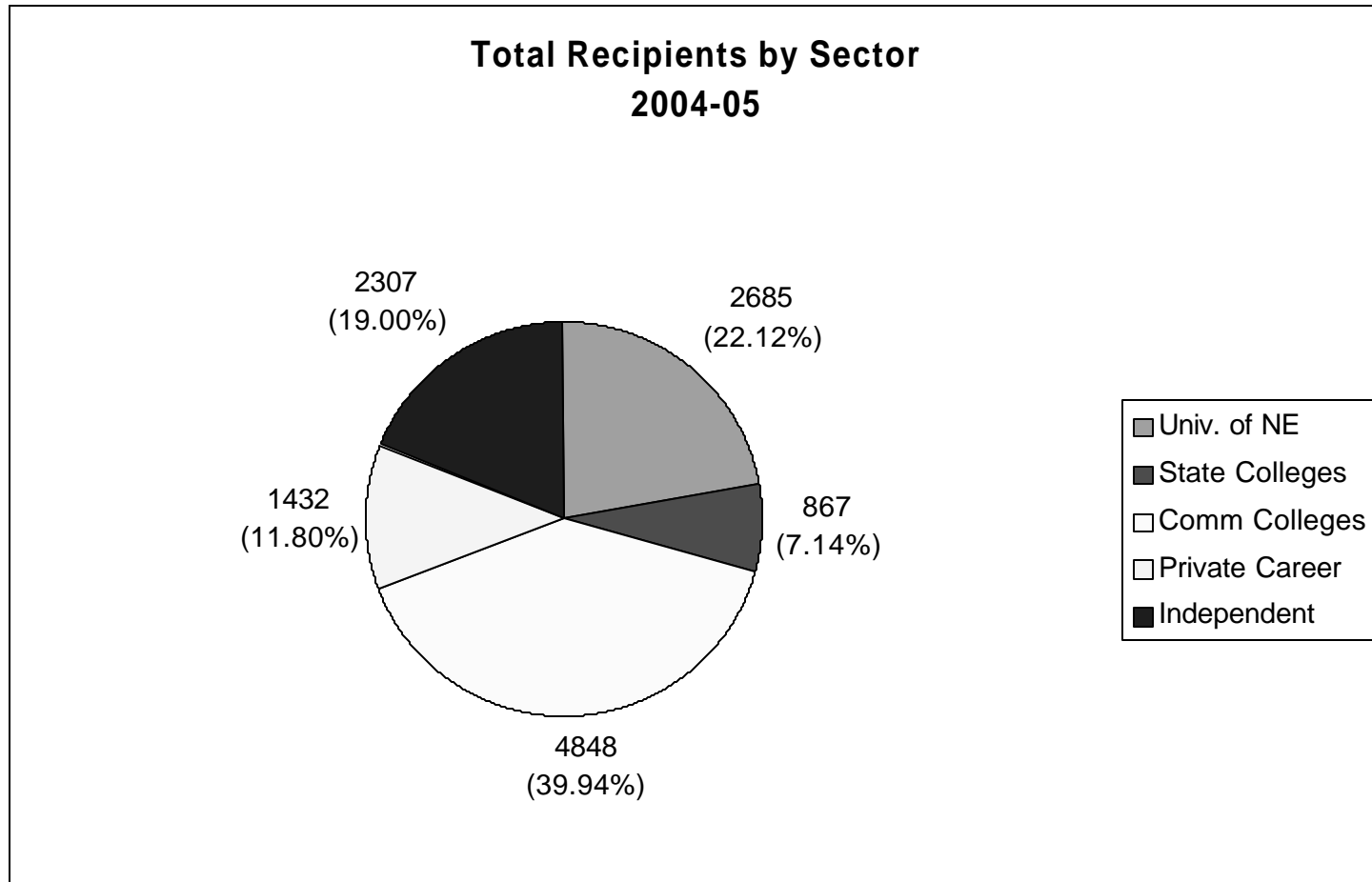
Awarding Process

- CCPE determines allocation for each institution based on formula in statute
- Institutions recommend students and amounts to be awarded
- CCPE approves or denies based on yearly maximums – institution and student

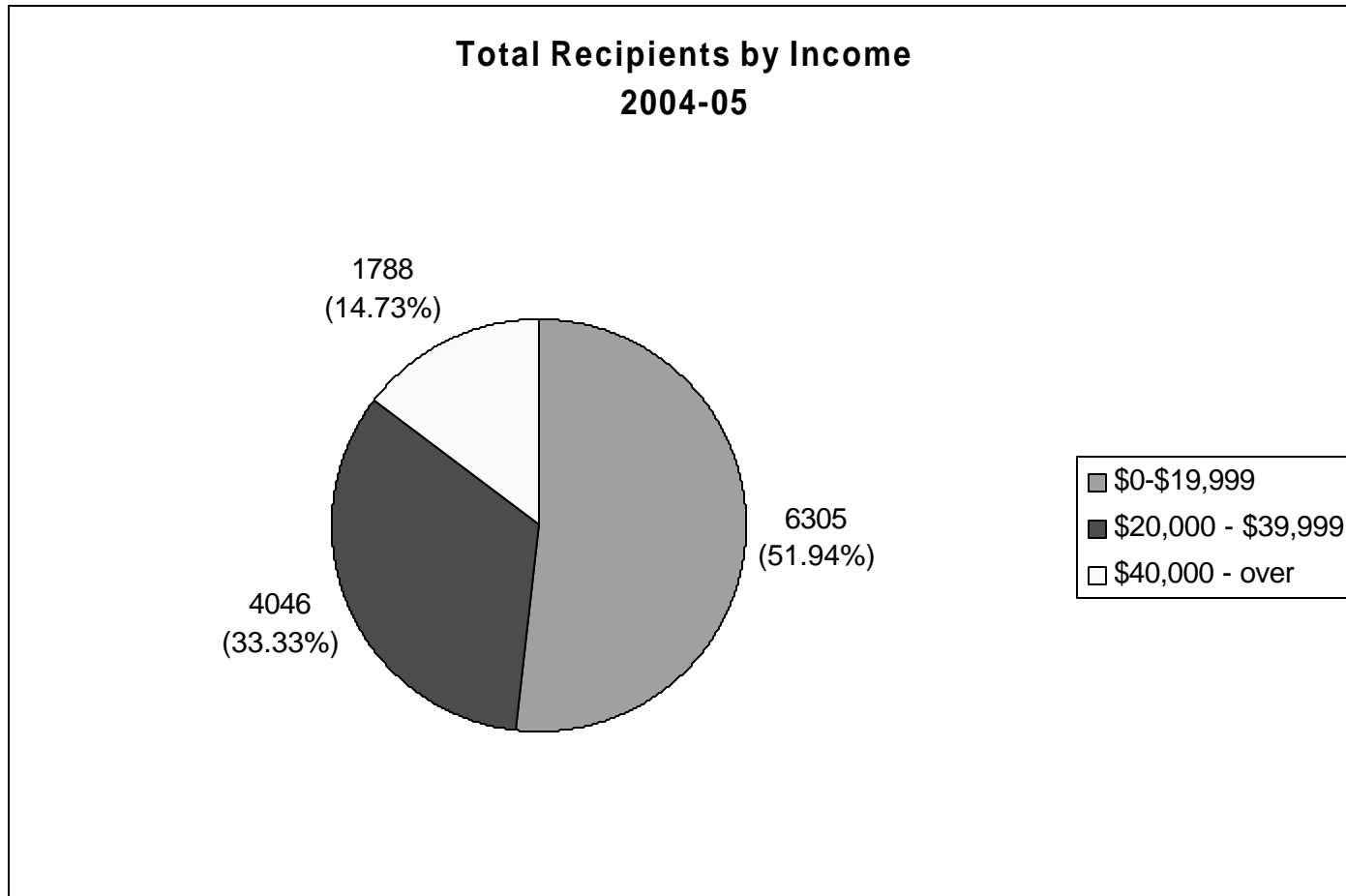
2004-05 NSG Info

- \$8,336,693.50 awarded
- 12,139 students received a NSG
- 41.87% of eligible students
- Average Grant - \$686.44 (\$25 - \$2389)

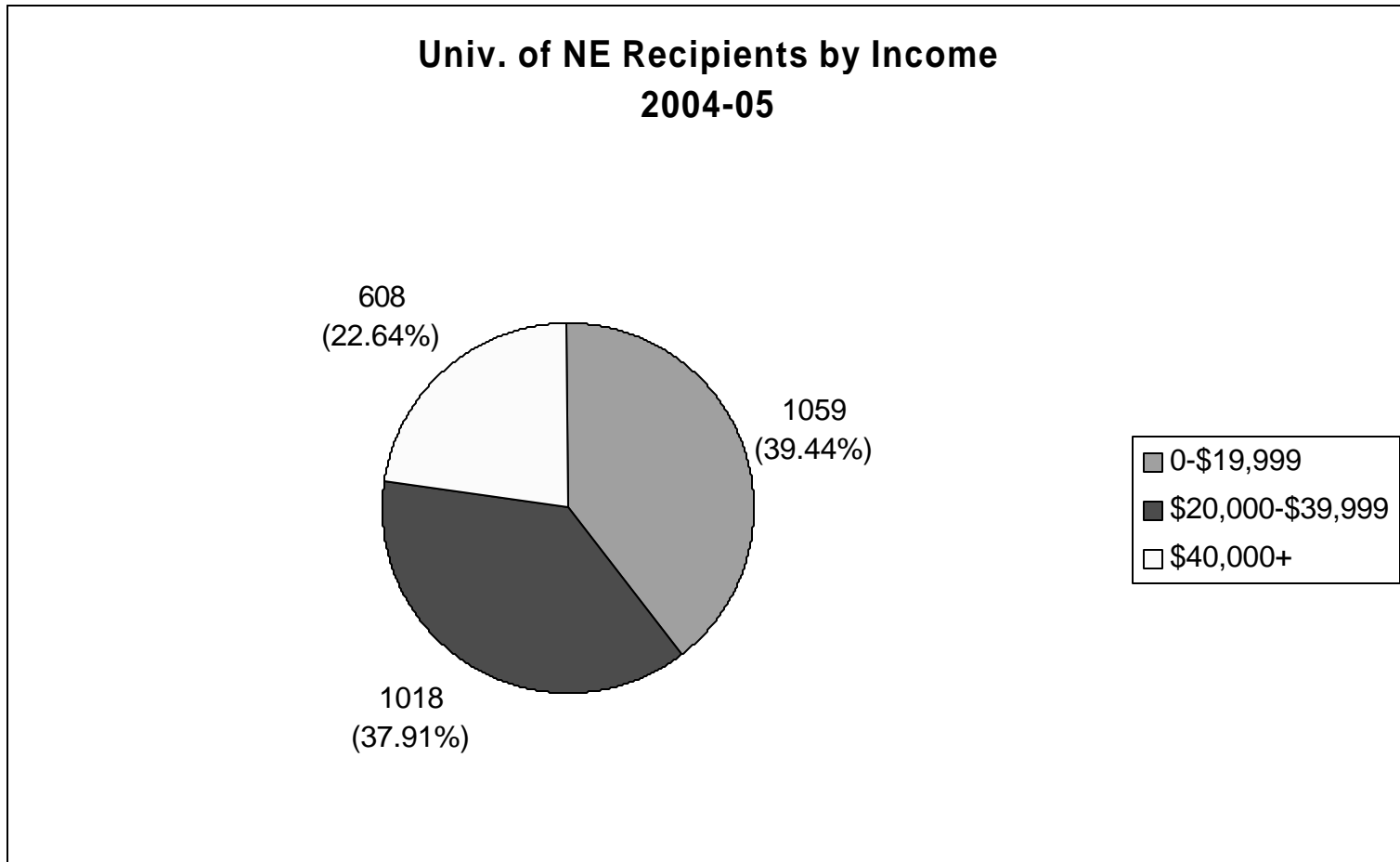
